### **1<sup>st</sup> RESERVATION TO BE MADE**

- **Book and confirm the availability of your Marriage Officer**
- **Your Marriage Officer will carry out all of the State Requirements i.e. finger prints, forms, registration of your marriage, etc.**

### **SPACE:**

- **Sufficient space for the bride's dress and for the bridal entourage**
- **Space for signing the register**
- **Space for DJ/musicians**

### **WEATHER**

- **Ensure that you and your guests are protected from the elements. (Have parasols/knee blankets on hand)**

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

- **Be sure that your Chapel venue has enough lighting for stunning photos to be taken.**

### **N.B. ELECTRICITY**

- **Does your Chapel Venue have a generator? YES NO**
- **Have a battery CD player (back-up on hand) – for the too often load-shedding**
